Library customers may use their own personal notebooks, laptops or other wireless accessible mobile devices.

These access points are unsecured, accessible only during normal Library hours and filtered to comply with CIPA regulations. As with other materials, **restriction of a child's access to the Internet is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.** As an assist with this responsibility we employ a filtering system.



A customer's use of this service is also governed by the Mid-Mississippi Regional Library System's Computer/Internet Access Policy, a copy of which is available at the Circulation Desk. Users who violate the terms of that policy, other library policies or use the network for abusive, malicious or illegal activity will be banned from the network and may be subject to prosecution. Users who wish to utilize this service must agree to the following conditions:



Access to the Internet at the Mid-Mississippi Regional Library System is provided as an information and reference resource. All users are expected to use the Libraries' wireless access in a legal and responsible manner, consistent with the educational and informational purposes for which it is provided. **Users are hereby notified that they are responsible for the choice of sites that they visit.** They are expected to bear in mind that the Library is a public place guided by our community's standards and **access websites that are appropriate in a public environment.**



Access to printers is not available via the wireless connection. If you need to print, please email the files to yourself -- then login to a wired public access Library workstation, connect to your email account and send print jobs to the public printer.



Signal strength varies depending on location in the Library and may not be available in all areas of the Library.



Library Staff cannot troubleshoot problems related to your wireless device or assist in making changes to your device's network settings and/or hardware configuration. The Library cannot guarantee that your device will work with the Library's wireless access points.



As with most public wireless "hot spots," the Library's wireless connection is not secure and any information being transmitted could potentially be intercepted by another wireless user. Cautious and informed wireless users should choose not to transmit personal information (credit card numbers, social security numbers, home addresses, PINs, passwords, online banking information, etc. or any other sensitive information) while using any wireless "hotspot." Please take appropriate precautions when using this service.



All wireless access users should have up-to-date virus protection on their laptop computers or wireless devices. The Library will not be responsible for any information that is compromised, or for any damage caused to your hardware or software due to electric surges, security issues, or consequences caused by viruses or hacking.



All Library policies apply to wireless access users.



It is illegal to use the Mid-Mississippi Regional Library System Internet connection for any purposes which violate U.S. or State laws, including, but not limited to transmission of obscenity, child pornography or defamatory speech. Users must comply with the United States copyright law and all other applicable laws.



Use of the Libraries' wireless network is entirely at the risk of the user. The Library disclaims all liability for loss of confidential information, damages resulting from that loss, or damages to personal devices as a result of use of the Libraries' wireless network.
